Scott was Danny Oliver's partner (working POP Team on October 24, 2014) and walked everyone through events that happened on that day and in the years that followed,

When coping with a traumatic event who should you talk to: co-workers; agency psychologist; clergy/member of your church; family members. Family members need to understand what you are going through.

There are companies that offer assistance/retreats: WCPR, SOS, COPS, PCIS & others.

Took $3\frac{1}{2}$ years to get to trial. Suspect received 2 death penalties, 3 life sentences plus 300 years. His wife received 70-80 years but may be out in five years due to a change in the Felony Murder Rule.
